WHO THE ROLE REPORTS TO	Engineering & Train Operations Manager or delegate, and under the direction of the locomotive crew rostered for the day
MINIMUM COMMITMENT	2 shifts per month
ROLE PURPOSE	To prepare, clean and polish Puffing Billy Railway’s locomotives safely and efficiently as required. Our engine cleaners ensure the locomotives always look their best for our visitors
SKILLS AND QUALITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Friendly and enjoy talking to the public • Enjoy being part of team-based activities • Interested in the preservation of locomotives and mechanical equipment • Reliable and punctual • Have an eye for detail • Not afraid of getting their hands dirty!
KEY DUTIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clean and polish steam locomotives as required • Split and stack firewood for locomotive light up • Clean out locomotive ashpans and ash pit • Assist the drivers and fireman with provisioning of supplies as required • Interpret and adhere to safety notices relevant to the workplace • Assist the locomotive crew with their tasks as required • Act as Puffing Billy Railway ambassador • Create and participate in photo opportunities for visitors as requested.
PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Willingness to work in all weather conditions • Ability to be on your feet for most of the shift • Standing on uneven surfaces for long periods • Working above and below ground (in servicing pits) • Working in an environment with hot surfaces, dust, heat and fumes.
